Progress on Bayou Bypass for Flood Control

The Linear Retention Channel that runs east-west just to the south of Willowbridge & Westbridge is undergoing some changes. The channel path is being cut through under Beltway 8 and regraded to allow the bayou bypass to flow from west to east.

The Linear Retention Channel that runs north-south between Willowbridge & Westbridge is be planted with trees by Harris County Flood Control.


START THE CHRISTMAS SEASON WITH "THE LITTLEST ANGEL"


