UPDATE ON PARK-EROSION CONTROL PROJECT AND GENERAL MAINTENANCE

Work is proceeding in the park by the engineering firm as planned. The geotechnical study and survey have been completed. Completion of the design for gabions (look like wire baskets filled with rocks) to support the fallen bridge and to prevent further erosion near the creek banks by the basketball court is targeted for Dec. 3. At that point we will take bids to find a contractor to build the gabions and put the bridge back in its place. Thanks for your patience while we work to make the park the best it can be.

Shattered globes and burnt out bulbs were replaced in the park on the lamp posts. One of the pond pumps that moves water from the lower pond into the upper is being repaired. The deck of the bridge near the playground was replaced with composite material that looks great and will wear much longer than regular wood.

The city came and cleaned all the debris under the Martin Parkway Bridge.

Pending projects: New signs (park rules, etc.) are being made for the park. The deck of the fallen bridge will be replaced as soon as the bridge is put back in its place.
