# Winchester Country Maintenance Association ANNUAL HOMEOWNER'S MEETING and ELECTION



#### Non-toxic Relief from Mosquitoes

That high pitch hum in your ear...summer is here and the mosquitoes have arrived. It's time to take action but let's keep the family protected and safe.

Don't use any mosquito spray that contains DEET (diethyl toluamide). DEET is a very effective insect repellant but not the best choice for the families' health.

DEET is a known neurotoxin, causes kidney and liver damage and has been implicated in birth and developmental defects. "Children in particular are at risk for subtle brain changes caused by chemicals in the environment, because their skin more readily absorbs them, and the chemicals more potently affect their developing nervous systems." <sup>1</sup> The World Health Organization (WHO) states that over 30% of the global burden of disease in children can be attributed to environmental factors, including pesticides.<sup>2</sup>

If the bottle of repellant you are planning to purchase contains DEET the label will say: may damage furniture finishes, watch crystals, leather, painted or varnished surfaces. This is a very harsh chemical that shouldn't be sprayed on the skin.

So what are some other options? Vinegar, either white or apple cider will work. Put it in a salad dressing bottle and sprinkle it on exposed skin. There are also herbal oils the are recommended such as tea tree, cedar, peppermint, citronella, eucalyptus and lemongrass. Mix these oils with cooking oil to dilute prior to putting on the skin.

If you wish to purchase insect repellant BUG OFF <sup>3</sup> from Dr. Mercola is a healthier option. It contains several of the essential oils listed above.

Mosquitoes are attracted to light colored clothing especially yellow. They zero in on fragrances from scented body care products, laundry detergents and scented fabric softeners. The use of unscented fragrance free products decreases the families' neurotoxic exposure but also keeps mosquitoes searching for another meal. Mosquitoes do not like the smell of garlic so by using a product called Mosquito Barrier( a very potent garlic solution) on the lawn, this will repel mosquitoes from the yard.

Check the external home environment. Be sure to empty any standing water around the home because this will provide the mosquitoes with a breeding ground. Consider putting up a bat house. A bat can eat approximately 600 mosquito sized insects an hour.

With these measures in place your family will probably not hear a high pitch hum in the ear this summer. The mosquitoes will find a better location than your home for their next meal.

#### **Winchester Country Pool Rules 2009**

- 1. All rules apply to Adults and Children.
- 2. Only registered Winchester Country and Winchester Meadows residents and their guests will be allowed to use the pool. Maintenance fees must be current and pool registration must be on file in Guard office at the pool.
- 3. All residents must hold current pool cards in order to use the pool.
- 4. The telephone located in Guard's Office and Guard Check-in Station is for emergency use only.
- 5. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult (18 years or older).
- 6. The baby pool is restricted to non-swimming children who are under the age of 5.
- 7. Non-swimming children must stay in the baby pool and within arm's reach of an adult. This also goes for the large pool.
- 8. All non-potty trained children must wear swim diapers at all times provided by the Resident.
- 9. Parents or Guardian are responsible for children and/or guests in both the baby pool and large pool at all times.
- 10. Running is not allowed in the pool area. No horseplay will be tolerated either in or out of the water.
- 11. Glassware/glass containers are not allowed in the pool area. No alcoholic beverages are allowed in the pool area. Users of the pool are responsible to clean their area and use facility trashcans to discard their trash.
- 12. Abusive/offensive language or gestures, screaming, yelling or the playing of loud music or music with inappropriate lyrics will not be tolerated.
- 13. Smoking is not allowed in the fenced area of the pool facility. There are designated smoking areas in front of the Coordinator office and Clubhouse II.
- 14. Diving is allowed from the diving board only. No diving in the shallow end. Divers must jump straight out and not toward the sides.
- 15. All persons younger than 18 years of age will leave the water during the scheduled hourly Lifeguard break / Adult swim period and sit away from the pool edge. Adults at least 18 years of age can swim at their own risk at this break time.
- 16. All swimmers must wear swim suits. No cutoffs are allowed.
- 17. Only Coast Guard approved floatation devices will be allowed and must be approved by the lifeguard staff.
- 18. Persons with bandages and/or open sores will not be allowed in the pool.
- 19. Cocoa butter, baby oil or other similar products will not be allowed in the pool. Commercial suntan preparations only.
- 20. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- 21. Gum chewing is not allowed in the water or pool area. All food is confined to the deck area only.
- 22. The Association is not responsible for lost or stolen items or unclaimed items on the "Lost & Found" shelf. Unclaimed items will be disposed of throughout the pool season.

- 23. All non-swimmers must wear Coast guard approved floatation devices.
- 24. Adult supervision is required at all times as relates to non-swimmers.
- 25. Only 2 non-swimmers per adult will be allowed.
- 26. All guests will be charged \$1 daily and may be issued a guest pass that must be returned upon leaving.
- 27. A resident must accompany all guests and is responsible for the guest's conduct.
- 28. No climbing on shade awning support poles or perimeter fencing.
- 29. Do not hold or hang on lane or diving-well ropes.
- 30. Do not talk to or distract lifeguards on duty.
- 31. All issues need to be reported to Senior Guard on duty.
- 32. The lifeguards on duty will have the final authority for the enforcement of pool rules and the overall safe operation of the facility both explicit and implied by the Pool Rules and must be obeyed at all times.

#### Discipline

Infractions to pool rules will result in disciplinary action taken by the contracted pool Management Company and/or Winchester Country Board of Directors. Disciplinary actions may include time out and/or the suspension of cards from one day up to and including the remainder of the pool season.
