SPRING CLEAN-UP

Many residents have begun their "Spring Clean-up". As a result, here are a few reminders to help with this process.

- *If you cut bush or tees, the branches must be bundled and no longer than four(4) feeti n length and no more than forty (40) pounds.
- *The trash men will not remove a pile of branches.
- *If you plan to paint your home, even the same color, you must apply for ACC approval before you begin this project. Call Chaparral Management at 28l-537-0957 and request an ACC form be sent to you or download one from the Fairwood website. Please remember to include a color sample with your application.
- *Driveways can be power washed to remove oil and other marks.
- *Flowerbeds should be weeded and then mulched to prevent weeds.
- *Trees should be trimmed away from stop signs and sidewalks to allow for visibility.
- *Clean your yard (front and back) from all debris piles. The mosquitoes and snakes like these places to live.
- *Be a good neighbor and repair fences between properties. These fences are "usually" shared and are both neighbors' responsibility.
- *Trim the bushes around your home. This enables the patrol in the neighborhood to have a good view of your home and does not give a place for an intruder to hide.
- *Help a neighbor that cannot do a project. This promotes" Good Will" and helps the neighborhood

- Trash and recycling are paid through the MUD#5 monthly bill
- Because of deed restrictions, trash cans must stay out of view unless it is trash day


POOL RULES

The Association hereby issues facility card access to the Association's pool located at 14701 Spring Cypress, Cypress, Harris County, Texas, subject to any rules and regulations of Fairwood H.O.A. for use of such facility, which are attached hereto and made a part hereof, and further specifically subject to the following:

Pool Rules

- 1. Proper ID is required to enter pool premises. Children 12 yrs and under must be accompanied at all times by an adult 18 yrs of age or older. Guests are limited to two (2) per registered member and must be accompanied by a member at all times.
- 2. No smoking, glass containers or alcohol allowed within the pool premises.
- 3. No food or drink allowed in the pool—no chewing gum in the pool area.
- 4. No running, rough housing, loud music, offensive or foul language.
- 5. No diving, flipping or jumping backwards into the shallow end of the pool.
- 6. No balls, Frisbees or throwing of objects in the pool area.
- 7. No skates, skate boards or bicycles allowed in the pool area.
- 8. No pets allowed in the pool area with the exception of Seeing Eye dogs.

- 9. Proper swimwear is preferred. No cutoffs, denim or dark clothing will be allowed. (These can cause damage to the pool equipment).
- 10.Persons with bandages, sores or open wounds are not allowed in the pool.



- 12. No un-consented physical touching of others.
- 13. In the event of inclement weather, lifeguards have the authority to close the pool and clear the pool premises based on guidelines of the American Red Cross and the National Institute of Lightning.
- 14. Parents or guardians are responsible for their children and must be within arm's length of non-swimming children or children in flotation devices.

15. Baby pool: Children must wear swim diapers—no disposables allowed. Only non-swimming children 5 yrs of age and younger are allowed in the baby pool and must be accompanied by a parent or guardian at all times.

Lifeguards are employed for the safety of the members and their guests. They have full authority to enforce any and all pool rules and suspend violator's pool privileges. Swimming is only allowed when a lifeguard is on duty. Trespassers will be prosecuted.

Violation of the pool rules can result in your pool privileges being revoked for 1-12 weeks depending on the degree and/or severity of the offense.

Baby Pool Rules

- 1. Lifeguards are not responsible for the children in the baby pool.
- 2. Children in the baby pool must be accompanied at all times by a parent or guardian within arm's reach.
- 3. Children must wear swim diapers—no disposables allowed.
- 4. Only non-swimming children 5 years of age and younger.
- 5. No diving or headfirst entries into baby pool.
- 6. No food or drink allowed in the baby pool.
