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

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SHERIFF GARCIA UNVEILS ANTI-CRIME RESOURCE

Harris County Sheriff Adrian Garcia announced today a new online tool for the public to use to find out about crime in county neighborhoods.

The consolidated crime reports system can be accessed by clicking on the "Crime Map" link on the home page of the Harris County Sheriff's Office's (HCSO) Web site, www.hcso.hctx.net <<http://www.hcso.hctx.net>> . It allows users to search for crime statistics based on an address, zip code, or city and state. Even more, Crime Reports allows users to sign up for e-mail crime alerts, empowering them with information they need to be on the look-out for trouble and work with law enforcement to head it off and help improve the safety of their neighborhood.

"This up-to-date online tool not only helps us understand crime trends but it provides transparency by putting our crime records in your hands, and accountability by

showing law-abiding residents our targets," said Sheriff Garcia. "Implementing this modern technology is just another step I'm taking to help make the sheriff's office a modern, 21st century crime-fighting agency." Users will be able to search for statistics based on crime types such as:

- o Homicide
- o Breaking and Entering
- o Robbery
- o Assaults
- o Sexual Offenses
- o Registered Sex Offenders
- o Property Crimes Theft
- o Theft of a vehicle
- o Theft from a vehicle

The online crime map will be updated several times a day with officer-written reports from not only the HCSO but partner law enforcement agencies such as all eight constable precincts.

This operation reclaims about 60% of all materials and ensures the remainder is disposed properly.

The process is so simple. Load up your hazardous waste, drive to the facility, and they unload it while you sit in your car!

The directions from Stone Gate are:

Take 290 Hwy to Gessner Exit, make a u-turn, and quickly get into the far right light to make the turn at the first street. (Hahl Road). The facility is on the right.

GATE ACCESS

Please keep your account current. Make sure we have your most current information i.e. land line telephone number and EZ tag numbers in your file. If your tags are not working or your name is not in the telephone entry please call 281-304-7448 or email stonegaterec@att.net us as soon as possible so we can re-enter your information.

All visitors during the time the gates are closed, weekends and daily between 7pm and 5:30am, will have to call the resident or the guard from the telephone entry key pad at the gate.

Deed Restriction Process

1ST LETTER: Notifying owner of violation and giving them (30 days) to cease and desist.

(Legally no further letters can go out for this violation until the (30 days) has expired)

2ND LETTER: After the (30 days) has expired from the 1st letter a 2nd letter notifying the owner of violation will be sent. (Please note that depending on what the violation is the board can send the account to the attorney when the (30 days) has expired from this letter.)

3RD LETTER: This letter is optional to the board and depending on what the violation is they do not always feel the need to send a 3rd letter.

Your Pets!

If you happen to come across vicious dogs, or ANY loose dogs of this nature, please contact your local sheriff's department 281-463-6666, Animal Control at 281-999-3191. If you are familiar with the property address the pets belong to, please feel free to submit that information to PCMI – Sarah Hudson at shudson@stes.com – to pursue the deed restriction violation. Notification and ample time must be given to the owner to correct the violation prior to any further pursuit by the Association.

It is a deed restriction violation if your pets are not confined to a fenced backyard or within your home. They must not be allowed to bark all night or cause a nuisance to your neighbors. They must also be on a leash at all times when not in a contained environment. It is also the pet owner's responsibility to keep **ALL** areas of the community **FREE** from pet debris when walking your pets. **PLEASE REMEMBER THAT CATS MUST ALSO BE CONFINED.** Animal Control can be reached at 281-999-3191.
