



- Clean up along Spring Cypress, north and south of Indian Harbor
- Repair to splashpark pump at the pool
- Repairs to pool fill line at the pool.
- Installation of extractor fans in the pool room / chemical room.
- Fountain pump repair / rebuild - Diamond Rock
- Replacement of corroded security doors at the pool
- Replacement of waterfall fountain pump and motor
- Lake wall repair - main lake (MUD project \$25,000)
- Replacement of the wooden fences around the Northlake Forest Drive pump station

Recipe of the Month TORTILLA SOUP

Ingredients

- 1 Onion, chopped
- ¼ Cup oleo
- ¼ Cup flour
- 6 cans chicken broth
- 3-4 chicken breasts; cooked and chopped
- 2 - 4 oz. cans chopped green chilies
- 1 can diced Rotel tomatoes or 1 can diced tomatoes
- 2 T chili powder
- 2 tsp. garlic salt
- 1 T Cumin
- 8 Corn tortilla chips, cut up
- 2 chopped avocados
- shredded Monterey Jack Cheese

Combine oleo and flour. Brown. Add broth, tomatoes, chilies, chicken, chili powder, cumin, garlic salt. Simmer for 1 hour. Saute onion and chips. Add to soup. Pour over cheese and avocados. Optional: Add sour cream.


