Winter Alert! Protect your Plants and Irrigation System

PROTECT YOUR PLANTS:

Water your plants thoroughly ahead of time. You need to be sure the roots are wet, not just the leaves. Much of freeze damage is from dehydration. Watering before a freeze could make a big difference in your tropicals and tender perennials.

Cover your tender plants. Remember, you want to be sure the roots are protected, covered, or mulched well. Even if you lose the top growth of these tender plants, if the roots are alive it'll come back in the spring. Don't cover with plastic touching the leaves of your plants. If at all possible, use woven frost protection sheets such



as N-Sulate (which can be folded, stored and reused for many years) or sheets and blankets. In a mild freeze or frost, one blanket will probably do for most plants. If it's a hard freeze (below 30 degrees for any period of time) use a heavy blanket or several layers of sheets. You can even use plastic over that if you want because it won't be touching the foliage. ALSO, don't forget to put rocks or something heavy on the edges of your N-Sulate or blanket to be sure the wind doesn't blow away, exposing the roots of your plant.

Don't do any heavy pruning on freeze-damaged plants until late winter when you think all chance of frost is over.

Remove all of your protective covering if the sun comes out and the temperature goes up, because it can be 32 degrees today and 70 degrees tomorrow.

Along with protecting your tender plants during the winter, remember it's not a good idea to fertilize tender tropicals that are exposed to outside temperatures during these cold months. Fertilizing encourages new growth and that new growth is more vulnerable to freezing and near freezing conditions than old growth. It's ok to fertilize and encourage growth on indoor or green-housed tropicals, although shorter days usually slow down growth no matter how much you fertilize.

PROTECT YOUR IRRIGATION SYSTEM:

Your backflow prevention device is the most important part of your irrigation system. It's also the most vulnerable part of your system if there is a freeze. It may be located somewhere right outside the garage and next to the foundation. Cover the top/ wrap with a towel the part that is above ground. It is best to turn your valve off.

MANAGER'S CORNER Dealing with Solicitors

Annoyed by the persistence of solicitors' unwelcome knocks on the door? It seems like no matter what they do, they always manage to show up on your front porch. They come with fliers, door hangers, a rehearsed speech and the distinct ability to ignore the polite decline of the products they're peddling—cleaning supplies, appliances, cosmetics, magazine subscriptions, home-improvement products, coupons for local businesses and other unwanted items—sometimes even making you feel trapped in your own home.

Homeowners associations are particularly easy, frequent targets of commercial, religious and political solicitors; part of the appeal is that population density makes our association an easy environment for them to canvas. Because of this, finding a way to keep solicitors away can be invaluable.

While the community has "No Soliciting" signs at the entrances, you can also help deter solicitors. The best way is by not buying their products. You can also post a small "No Solicitors" sign on your door or in your front window. If you get knocks on the door anyway, DO NOT open the door! If you speak to the solicitors through a window and they tell you they have permission to solicit in Summerwood that would not be truthful!

While a visit from a solicitor is often annoying, they can sometimes be more than just a nuisance; some might have ulterior motives, such as fraud, canvassing a home to commit a crime or other unseemly behavior. If you believe a solicitor is acting suspiciously or if you feel threatened, please immediately call the Precinct 3 Constable Dispatch number- 281-427-4791 to help you avoid a potentially dangerous situation. Hopefully be able to give a description of what they look like, what they are wearing ...or possibly what time of vehicle they are driving.

So stay safe, keep your sanity and do your part in discouraging solicitors from trolling our community. You'll soon hear just how sweet an un-rung doorbell sounds.





2015 HOUSING PREDICTIONS
