Update on Annual Reserve Assessment

As some of our homeowners may recall, a Special Meeting was held in October last year where the Board proposed raising the 2015 Annual Reserve Assessment. There was a quorum of owners at the Special Meeting in person, or by proxy, for the purpose of reviewing

and presenting the proposed Amendment but there was insufficient members represented at the meeting to finalize the vote and, as a result, the Association was left with eleven months to obtain the necessary votes in favor of the Amendment before the voting process becomes invalid.

The Board revisited the proposed Amendment in early April in an effort to complete the voting process prior to the Annual Meeting but, for various reasons, were unable to get the required number of homeowners to vote on the amendment such that a count could to be taken at the Annual Meeting.

It is imperative that all our homeowners vote given the stringent requirements in place for both triggering the count and for obtaining a decisive result regarding the proposal. Consequently, the Board will continue to push for the proposed increase in the Reserve Assessment and to look for ways, over the coming months, to collect the outstanding votes necessary to carry the proposal.

Should any of our homeowners have any questions regarding the need for the increase in the Reserve Assessment, or wish to help in any way with regard to vote collection, they should feel free to reach out to a Board member to obtain the relevant information and/or blank proxy ballot papers. For those homeowners who have not already voted a proxy ballot paper can be obtained by contacting a Board member.
