
Ladies of LOE Meet

Girl Scouting is open to all girls ages 5 (must be in kindergarten) through 17 who are willing to accept the Girl Scout Promise and Law. Daisy, Brownie, Junior, Cadette, Senior and Ambassador Girl Scout programs are geared to their particular age levels and interests.

Don't forget that many of our most exciting opportunities are available to older girls! Girls may join at any level, and no previous Scouting experience is required. Older girls whose schedules do not allow for participation in a troop or group may still want to participate as "Juliettes" (individual Girl Scouts). We have many special interest groups for activities such as backpacking, archery, horseback riding and sailing. Our Council






